Clifford Family Farm would like to invite you to be a part of our Market CSA for the 2019 growing season. CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. Signing up for the CSA helps our farm with upfront costs at the beginning of the season so we can provide healthy, delicious produce to you all season long! By joining our market CSA you create an account with us that can be used to buy produce at any of our markets, we will also add an additional bonus to your account to be used throughout the season. Please read through the additional details and benefits below, and send in the form along with payment.

How the CSA works:

- Choose your account size:
 - \$250 will receive a 8% bonus, your account balance starts at \$270
 - \$300 receives a 10% bonus, your initial account balance will be \$330
 - \$400 receives a 15% bonus, your initial account balance will be \$460
- You can choose to spend your account on any vegetables, fruits, or flowers we have available at market

- You are not committed to picking up vegetables each week. You can choose to spend more or less of your account in a given week depending on what crops are available.
- No cash will be needed at Clifford Family Market stands. Any purchases are deducted from your account.
- Enjoy the experience and the community! Try new crops, learn new recipes, and socialize at markets. Join us for occasional events at the farm.
- Any account balance left at the end of the season is rolled over into the next year. You can re-up your account midway through the season if you run out (same bonuses will apply).

What to expect through the season:

Spring (June- Early July)	Arugula, Lettuce, Radishes, Beets, Carrots, Turnips, Broccoli, Broccoli Rabb, Spinach, Cabbage, Fennel, Kale, Chard, Scallions, Peas
Summer (July-August)	Beans, Potatoes, Tomatoes, Summer Squash, Cucumbers , Eggplant, Onions, Garlic, Peppers, Melons
Fall (September- October)	Tomatoes, Potatoes, Sweet Potatoes, Winter Squash, Peppers, Carrots, Beets, Turnips, Scallions, Lettuce, Onions , Greens, Cabbage, Broccoli, Radishes, Kale
